Are you an emerging creator with a passion for sports, storytelling, and building something meaningful? Do you thrive in collaborative, fast-paced environments where creativity fuels real impact? The Creators Academy provides emerging creators with hands-on experience and networking opportunities to help them find their footing in the creative industry, sports business, and beyond over the course of two (2) days. Designed to support local creators early in their journey, the program offers opportunities to develop impactful pieces and expand professional networks.

Creators will learn directly from key personnel and adjacent departments, gaining insight into how creative and content fuel the business and contribute to broader organizational goals.

If you're ready to learn, create, and grow alongside experienced professionals, our two (2)-day Creators Academy consultant role may be the experience for you!

Applicants can apply to three (3) different roles within the program: Photographer, Videographer, and/or Designer. What the program includes:

- One (1) day of an in-person shadowing experience, including the opportunity to network with the Boston Celtics Creative & Content and Social Teams.
- Photographer and Videographer receive the opportunity to work as a consultant to photograph or film, respectively, one (1) Boston Celtics regular season home game at the direction of the Boston Celtics Creative & Content Team.
- Designer receives the opportunity to work as a consultant for one (1) day to design a package of digital illustrations to support a Boston Celtics regular season home game.
- The opportunity for the produced content to be published to Boston Celtics-controlled social media channel(s).
- The opportunity to participate in instructional and networking meetings, and feedback reviews with industry professionals.
- Opportunity to receive a professional headshot and feature on Celtics.com.

Qualifications:

We're seeking creators who are:

- A current resident of Massachusetts, Rhode Island, New Hampshire, Vermont, or Maine who live within a one hundred fifty (150) mile radius of Boston, Massachusetts, or who live within a seventy-five (75) mile radius of Boston, Massachusetts with the ability to travel to the Boston Celtics headquarters and TD Garden in downtown Boston, MA for the two (2) days of programming.
- Passionate about storytelling, content creation, and sports culture.
- Curious, motivated, and eager to learn in a fast-paced, collaborative environment.
- Comfortable taking feedback and applying it to improve their work.
- Interested in exploring careers in sports photography, videography, or graphic design.
- Eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of application.

Hourly rate: Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per hour associated with the work performed in connection with the content production, with specific working hours to be determined by the Boston Celtics in their sole. Successful completion of a background check and consultant agreement are required.

About Company:

Throughout the Boston Celtics' storied history, they have long stood for equality and respect, including drafting the first African American player, hiring the first African American coach, and playing the first all-black starting five. The Celtics have won a record 18 NBA Championships spanning six decades, including eight in a row from 1959-1966, and winning their most recent in 2024. In addition, 51 former Celtics players, management, coaches, or staff have been inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. The team has been operating under local ownership since 2002.
