

Season in Review

Darius Garland, who was an NBA All-Star in 2021-22, finished the season with career highs in points (21.7), assists (8.6), rebounds (3.3), steals (1.31), FG% (.462), FT% (.892), double-doubles (29) and minutes (35.7), and placed 3rd in the league's Most Improved Player of the Year voting.



CAVALIERS KEY DATES IN THE 2021-22 SEASON

October 20 – Evan Mobley became the 2nd player in NBA history to have 17 points, nine rebounds, six assists, one steal and one block in their league debut (Deandre Ayton had 18 PTS, 10 REB, 6 AST, 1 STL, 1 BLK on Oct. 17, 2018 vs. DAL) [via Elias Sports Bureau].

October 20 – Jarrett Allen finished with 25 points (on a perfect 11-11 FG) , three steals and three blocks in 29 minutes at Memphis. He became the 1st player in the shot clock era (since 1954) to go 10-for-10 or better from the floor in their team's season-opening game [via Elias Sports Bureau]. It was just the 3rd time EVER that a Cavalier has shot 11-11 FG or better in a single game, including the 2nd time by Allen (2/21/21 vs. OKC, 11-11 FG). The only other Cavalier to go 11-11 FG or better was Johnny Warren (12/14/73 vs. BUF, 12-12 FG).

October 20 – Darius Garland (13 PTS and career-high-tying 12 AST) and Ricky Rubio (12 PTS, 10 AST) each recorded double-doubles vs. Memphis. They also became the 1st Cavs teammates to hand out 10+ AST apiece in a single game since Kyrie Irving (14 AST) and LeBron James (12 AST) on Feb. 1, 2017 vs. MIN.

October 22 – Collin Sexton became the 1st player in Cavs history with 30+ points on .600+ shooting from the field (33 PTS on 13-21 - .619 FG%) in a Cavs home opener and was the 4th player in Cavs history to record 30+ points in a Cavs home opener..



October 23 – Against Atlanta, Evan Mobley became the 2nd rookie in NBA history to average 15.0+ PPG, 8.0+ RPG, 3.0+ APG, 2.0+ BPG and 1.0+ SPG through his first 3 career games.

October 23 – Kevin Love (6,331 PTS) passed World B. Free (6,329 PTS) for 11th place on the Cavs all-time scoring list and finished with 12 points, six rebounds and three assists in 24 minutes vs. the Hawks.

October 23 - The Cavs went on a 21-0 run against Atlanta starting with less than a minute in the second quarter (46-55) and regained the lead in the 3rd quarter leading 67-55 at the end of the run. It was the biggest Cavs run since going on a 24-0 run on Dec. 11, 2019 vs. Houston.

October 25 – With his first defensive rebound in a win at Denver, Kevin Love (3,054 DREB) passed John "Hot Rod" Williams (3,049 DREB) for sole possession of 5th on the Cavaliers all-time defensive rebounds list.

November 1 – Jarrett Allen led Cleveland at Charlotte become the first Cavs player with 24+ PTS, 16+ REB, 3+ BLK and 1+ STL in a game since LeBron James (31 PTS, 19 REB, 3 BLK, 4 STL) on Jan. 11, 2008 vs. CHA.

Allen became one of only three players in the shot-clock era (since 1954-55) to shoot .730+ FG on 45+ FGM through the first 8 games of a season (Wilt Chamberlain 46-58, .793 in 1972-73 and Rudy Gobert 51-69, .739 in 2018-19).

November 3 – Against Portland at home, Evan Mobley became the first Cavs rookie to record back-to-back double-doubles since Matthew Dellavedova (March 20 & 22, 2014).

November 5 – Across the border in Toronto, The Cavaliers secured a 102-101 victory and didn't secure their first lead until under .05 seconds left in regulation. They became the first Cavaliers team since at least 1996-97 to win a game securing their first lead with .05 or less in the game (last NBA team was BOS on Dec. 28, 2017).

November 5 – Through Evan Mobley's first 10 career games, he totaled 138 PTS (13.3 PPG), 79 REB (7.9 RPG), 23 AST (2.3 APG), 10 STL (1.0 SPG) and 14 BLK (1.4 BPG), becoming just the 4th player in NBA history to reach those marks in their first 10 career games (Lamar Odom, Mychal Thompson and Bill Walton).

November 7 – In a win over the Knicks, Ricky Rubio finished with a career-high 37 points on 13-19 (.684) shooting from the field and career-high 8-9 (.889) from beyond the arc to go with 10 assists, three rebounds and one steal in 31 minutes off the bench. He became the first player in NBA history with 30+ PTS, 10+ AST and 8+ three-pointers in a game off the bench and the first player in NBA history with 37+ PTS, 10+ AST and 8+ three-pointers on .800+ 3FG%. He also became the first Cavs player in team history to make his first 8 three-point attempts of a game [via Elias Sports Bureau].

November 7 – Evan Mobley finished with a career-high 26 points on a career-best 11-15 (.733) shooting from the field, nine rebounds, five assists, one block and one steal in 36 minutes in a win over the Knicks. He was the first Cavaliers rookie in franchise history to record 26+ PTS, 9+ REB, 5+ AST and .733+ FG% in a game and first NBA rookie to do so since Blake Griffin on April 6, 2011.

November 12 – In a 98-78 win over the Pistons at home, Cleveland held Detroit to the lowest opponent points total allowed by the Cavs since Jan. 20, 2016 (78 PTS).

November 12 – With his 5th board against Detroit, Evan Mobley became the first Cavalier to record 100 career rebounds in 13 games or less since Brad Daugherty (100th REB in 12th game) and John "Hot Rod" Williams (100th REB in 13th game), both in 1986-87.

November 13 – In a win over Boston, the Cavs went on a 21-2 run to grab their first lead of the game (77-76) at the 6:43 mark of the fourth quarter. It was their largest come-from-behind victory (19 points) since Feb. 24, 2020 vs. Miami (overcame a 22-point deficit). The Cavs held the Celtics to 15 points in the 4th quarter, tying their season-low for opponent points in the final period (15 in 4th at LAC on Oct. 27).

CAVALIERS KEY DATES IN THE 2021-22 SEASON

November 13 – Evan Mobley recorded his 200th career point with his first bucket of the game, becoming the first Cavaliers rookie in team history to record 200 points and 100 rebounds in 14 games or fewer.

November 15 – Against Boston, Cedi Osman passed Mo Williams (414 3FGM) for 9th on the Cavaliers all-time three-point list.

November 17 – Kevin Love grabbed his 2,000th career offensive rebound in Brooklyn, becoming the 11th active NBA player to reach that mark

November 22 – Jarrett Allen played in his 300th career NBA game.

November 27 – Against Orlando, Garland became the 4th-youngest Cavs player ever to reach 2,000 points. He finished the game with 26 points, 11 assists, four rebounds and one steal in 36 minutes of play.

December 3 – With a 111-96 win over Dallas, The Cavs swept a 3-game road trip, beating Dallas (111-96), Miami (111-85) and Washington (116-101), all of which had winning records. It was just the 2nd time in franchise history that Cleveland swept a road trip of 3+ games against .500 teams (Dec. 16-19, 1975).

December 5 – Jarrett Allen finished with a career-best 7th consecutive double-double, contributing 17 PTS and 11 REB, 2 STL and 2 BLK in 32 MIN against Utah.

December 11 – Jarrett Allen recorded his 100th career double-double, finishing with 19 PTS and 11 REB in 39 MIN vs. Sacramento.

December 13 – Ricky Rubio became the 12th active player with 5,000 career assists in a win over Miami, finishing the game with 7 PTS, 3 REB, a game-high 7 AST and 1 STL in 28 MIN off the bench

December 18 - The Cavs' last 10 wins to this point had all been won by 10+ PTS, the team's longest streak of consecutive wins by 10+ PTS since Nov. 13-Dec. 9, 2008 (12 straight wins by 10+ points).

December 25 – Cleveland extended Head Coach J.B. Bickerstaff through the 2026-27 season.

December 31 – Brandon Goodwin made his Cavaliers debut, finishing with 13 PTS on 6-9 (.667) shooting from the field, 4 REB and 6 AST in 25 MIN of play.

January 4 – Evan Mobley became one of only six players all-time since blocks became an official stat (1973-74) to average 14.0+ PPG, 8.0+ RPG, 1.5+ BPG and .500+ FG% though the first 30 games of a career (Chris Webber - 1993-94, Ralph Sampson - 1983-84, Bill Cartwright 1979-80, Artis Gilmore 1976-77, Bobby Jones 1976-77) [via Elias Sports Bureau].

January 7 - With a 114-101 in Portland, Cleveland secured a record of 22-17 on the season matching its win total from all of last season (22-50 in 2020-21), reaching the mark in 31 fewer games (won their 22nd game in their 70th game in 2020-21).

January 12 – Darius Garland recorded his first career triple-double against Utah, finishing with 11 PTS, 10 REB and 14 AST. He became the 4th youngest player in Cavs history to notch a triple-double, behind only LeBron James, Brad Daugherty and Kyrie Irving.

January 14 – Darius Garland became the second Cavaliers player all-time under the age of 22 to finish a game with 30+ PTS, 8+ AST, 4+ REB, 1+ STL and 1+ BLK, joining LeBron James (12 times).

January 17 – Darius Garland led the Cavaliers to an NBA-best 4-0 record in the week prior, will all four victories occurring on the road against Western Conference opponents. Garland posted a double-double in three games, including one triple-double performance, while averaging 20.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 12.8 assists (second-best in NBA) and 1.0 steal in 35.5 minutes per contest.

January 22 - Against the Thunder, Mobley tallied his 9th double-double of the season (15 PTS and a career-high 17 REB). Mobley's 17 rebounds are the most by a Cavs rookie since Zydrunas Ilgauskas (also 17 rebounds) on March 4, 1998. Mobley also surpassed 300 REB and 100 AST for the season in the game, becoming just the 2nd rookie in NBA history to have 570+ PTS, 300+ REB, 100+ AST, 65+ BLK, 30+ STL and shooting .500+ FG% in their first 39 games or fewer (Chris Webber in 1993-94).

January 24 – Darius Garland recorded his 5th straight game of 10+ PTS and 10+ AST, becoming the 7th Cavalier EVER with 5+ games straight of 10 PTS and 10 AST and first since LeBron James (5 straight from Dec. 9-17, 2017).

January 26 – Jarrett Allen contributed his team-leading 26th double-double of the season with 10 PTS, a game-high 10 REB, and 1 STL in 33 MIN against Milwaukee. With the double-double, Allen surpassed his double-double total from the previous season (25).

January 31 – Evan Mobley scored in double figures for his career-best 17th straight game , the longest streak by a Cavs rookie since Collin Sexton (23 games) from Feb. 23-April 9, 2019.

February 1 – Evan Mobley and Isaac Okoro were selected to participate in the 2022 Clorox Rising Stars Game at the 2022 NBA All-Star Weekend in Cleveland.

February 2 – Kevin Love became the 7th player in Cavaliers history to record 4,000 career rebounds with the franchise in a game against Houston.

February 3 – Darius Garland was selected as and NBA All-Star Reserve, marking his first career NBA All-Star selection.

February 4 – Jarrett Allen recorded a career-high 29 PTS (12-20 FG) and a season-high 22 REB (career-high 11 OREB) in 34 MIN. It was his 3rd career 20-20 game and he also became the 10th NBA player this season with 20+ PTS and 20+ REB (1st player this season with 29+ PTS and 22+ REB). Allen was the 12th different player in Cavs history to have 20+ PTS and 20+ REB in a game. His 11 OREB were 1 shy of tying the Cavs single game record and he was the first Cavalier since Tristan Thompson on Oct. 31, 2014 (12 OREB) to record 11+ OREB.

February 6 – Cedi Osman recorded 18 points in the 4th quarter against Indiana (career high for points in a quarter) on 7-8 (.875) shooting from the field, including 4-5 (.800) shooting from beyond the arc. He is the first Cavs player to score 18+ points in a quarter since LeBron James on April 6, 2018 at PHI (19 PTS in 3Q). Osman also scored his 3,000th career point with his fourth point of the game.

CAVALIERS KEY DATES IN THE 2021-22 SEASON

February 11 – Rajon Rondo tallied 17 PTS on 6-7 (.857) shooting, 7 REB, 6 AST and a game-high tying 3 STL in 33 MIN off the bench against the Pacers. He was just the 2nd Cavs player in team history with those numbers on .850+ shooting from the field (Larry Nance Jr.: 18 PTS, 15 REB, 7 AST, 4 STL, .875 FG% on 12/29/18). It was the first time in Rondo's career with those numbers on .850+ shooting from the field.

February 14 – Jarrett Allen was named an NBA All-Star reserved, his first All-Star selection of his career.

February 15 – Kevin Love recorded his 14,000th career point against Atlanta, becoming the 4th player in NBA history with 14,000+ PTS, 8,000+ REB and 1,400+ 3FG (Dirk Nowitzki, Jason Kidd and LeBron James).

February 18-20 – Rocket Mortgage FieldHouse hosted 2022 NBA All-Star Weekend in Cleveland. On Friday night, Evan Mobley and Isaac Okoro played for Team Barry in the Rising Stars, helping the team capture the mini-tournament championship. On All-Star Saturday Night, Team Cavs (Allen, Garland, Mobley) were victorious in the Skills Challenge, marking the 1st time in franchise history any Cavalier player won the event. In Sunday's NBA All-Star Game, Jarrett Allen (10 PTS, 9 REB, 2 BLK) and Darius Garland (13 PTS, 3 AST, 2 STL) both had strong performances in Team LeBron's 163-160 victory over Team Durant.

February 26 – Lauri Markkanen finished with 23 points vs. Washington, putting him at exactly 4,000 points for his career.

February 28 – Brandon Goodwin recorded his first career double-double with 17 points (7-13 FG), a career-high 12 assists (0 turnovers), 4 rebounds and 2 steals in 35 minutes vs. Minnesota. He was just the 3rd Cavalier since 2000 to have 17+ PTS, 12+ AST and 0 turnovers in a game, joining Andre Miller (5 times) and LeBron James (4 times).

March 4 – Darius Garland finished with a team-high 26 points, a career-high 19 assists, two steals and one block in 43 minutes. Garland is the 2nd player in Cavaliers history with 26+ PTS and 19+ AST (Andre Miller, 27 PTS and 19 AST at MIL on Feb. 13, 2002). He was just the third player in the NBA since 1990 with 26+ PTS, 19+ AST, 2+ STL and 1+ BLK (John Stockton, Russell Westbrook).

March 6 – Evan Mobley recorded 20 points on 9-15 (.600) shooting from the field, a career-high tying 17 rebounds, four assists and a game-high three blocks in 36 minutes vs. Toronto. Mobley became just the 5th rookie in Cavaliers history to record 2+ games with 17+ REB as a rookie joining Zdrunas Ilgauskas (1997-98), Hot Rod Williams (1986-87), Bill Laimbeer (1980-81) and Dave Sorenson (1970-71).

March 8 - Cleveland recorded a season-high tying 13 steals against Indiana and recorded a season-low seven turnovers, marking the first time the Cavs had 13+ STL and 7 or fewer TO in the same game since April 4, 2014 at ATL (6 TO, 13 STL).

March 14 – Evan Mobley became the 4th rookie in Cavs history with 100 blocks in their rookie season, joining Hot Rod Williams (1986-87), Roy Hinson (1983-84) and Zdrunas Ilgauskas (1997-98).

March 18 – Lauri Markkanen recorded his 3rd double-double of the season versus Denver, tallying a season-high 31 points (11-18 FG, 6-12 3FG), 10 rebounds, three assists and a career-high tying four steals in 42 minutes. It was Markkanen's 8th career game with 30+ PTS and 10+ REB.

March 21 – Cedi Osman became the 9th Cavalier in team history to record 500 3FG with the franchise.

March 26 – Kevin Love became the 2nd player in Cavaliers history to make 1,000 3FG with the franchise on Saturday vs. CHI, joining LeBron James (1,251 3FG).

March 30 – Darius Garland recorded his 3,000th career point vs. Dallas, becoming the 4th-youngest Cavs player ever to reach that mark (22y, 62d), joining LeBron James (20y, 62d), Kyrie Irving (21y, 295d) and Collin Sexton (22y, 20d).

March 30 - Caris LeVert chipped in a team-high 32 points six rebounds and four assists in 38 minutes. He scored 21 of his points in the 1st half.

March 31 – Darius Garland finished the month of March (16 games) averaging 25.3 PPG, 10.7 APG, 3.5 RPG and 1.56 SPG in 39.1 MPG. Garland also dished out 171 AST in the month of March, the most assists in a month in Cavs history (previous high was John Bagley – 169 AST in December 1985).



March 31 – Kevin Love recorded his 154th 3FG off the bench this season in Atlanta, passing Kyle Korver (153 3FG off the bench in 2017-18) for most triples off the bench in a season in Cavs history.

April 5 – Kevin Love passed Larry Nance for 9th on the Cavaliers all-time scoring list.

April 10 – Kevin Love finished with a game-high 32 points on 10-16 (.625) shooting from the field, including 8-11 (.727) shooting from beyond the arc, a team-high tying 10 rebounds, two assists and one steal in 15 minutes off the bench. His five three-pointers were tied for the second-most triples in a quarter in his career and 5th time he has recorded 5+ three pointers in any quarter. Love became the first player in the shot clock era (since 1954) to record 30+ PTS and 10+ REB in 15 or fewer minutes (via Elias Sports Bureau).

April 10 - The Cavs finished the regular season 44-38, improving their win total by 22 wins from the previous season (22-50). The 22-win improvement is the 2nd-largest win improvement by a Cavs team in franchise history.

April 12 - The Cavs made their first-ever NBA Play-In tournament appearance for a chance to make the postseason in a matchup with the Brooklyn Nets.

April 15 - The Cavs hosted their first-ever Play-In tournament game at Rocket Mortgage FieldHouse, facing the Atlanta Hawks. Cleveland dropped the nail-biting contest 107-101 to complete their 2021-22 campaign.

CLEVELAND CAVALIERS 2021-22 SEASON NOTES

DOUBLE UP: The Cavaliers finished the regular season **44-38**, doubling their win total from 2020-21 (22-50). The **22-win improvement is the 2nd-largest win improvement by a Cavs team in franchise history**. Cleveland finished as the No. 8 seed in the Eastern Conference and played in its first ever NBA Play-In Tournament. The Cavs 44 wins were the most since the 2017-18 season (50-32).

JUMP, JUMP: Cleveland had the **2nd-highest jump in win percentage in the NBA this past season** (highest in the Eastern Conference) at $+.231$ (.306 to .537) behind only the Minnesota Timberwolves $+.242$ (.319 to .561).

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Cavs finished the season ranking **5th in the NBA in defensive rating (108.9)** and **5th in the NBA in opponent PPG (105.7)**. They were also **8th in opponent FG% (.452)** and **3rd in the NBA in second chance points allowed per game (12.5)**.

DG THE ALL-STAR PG: Darius Garland completed the regular season averaging **career-highs in points (21.7), assists (8.6), rebounds (3.3), steals (1.31), FG% (.462), FT% (.892), double-doubles (29) and minutes (35.7)**. finished **3rd place in the NBA's Most Improved Player award voting** and was an **NBA All-Star** for the first time in his career.

- Garland **joined LeBron James as the only players in Cavs history to finish a season with 20.0+ PPG and 8.0+ APG**.
- He ranked **4th in the NBA in point-assist double-doubles (29)**, **6th in assists (8.6 APG)** and **7th in FT% (.892)**.
- Garland scored **20+ points in 42 of his 68 games**, the **5th-most 20+ point games for a Cavs player 22 years old or younger**.
- Garland was **1 of only 3 players in the NBA this past season** to average **19.0+ PPG, 7.0+ APG and .460+ FG%** (Nikola Jokic, Dejeunte Murray).

- Garland earned **NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week honors for the week of Jan. 10-16** and had a stretch of five straight games with at least 10 assists in January (Jan. 15-24), becoming just the second Cavs player to accomplish that feat since 2003 (LeBron James).
- Additionally, Garland became the **4th-youngest player in Cavaliers history to notch a triple-double in a win at Utah on Jan. 12** (LeBron James, Brad Daugherty, Kyrie Irving) and just the **3rd player in NBA history to have a game of at least 27 points, 18 assists and five rebounds before age 22** during Cleveland's victory at Oklahoma City on Jan. 15 (Trae Young, Luka Dončić).
- After the All-Star break, Garland averaged **24.8 points and 10.0 assists over the final 21 games**. During that span, he dished out a career-high 19 assists on March 4 at Philadelphia, which was tied for the most assists by any player in the NBA this past season (Chris Paul, twice).
- Garland also recorded a **career-high 41 points, to go along with 13 assists, five rebounds and two steals** in a win at Indiana on March 8, becoming **one of just six players in NBA history at age 22 or younger to tally at least 40 points, 10 assists, five rebounds and two steals** in a single game (Michael Jordan, LeBron James, Isaiah Thomas, Chris Webber, Luka Dončić).
- Became the **fastest Cavaliers player to make 300 career three-pointers, doing so in his 147th game** (Jan. 9 at Golden State), and already ranks 11th in team history in threes made (384).

IMPACTFUL ROOKIE: Evan Mobley, the runner-up for the 2021-22 NBA Rookie of the Year award and a unanimous All-Rookie First Team selection finished his rookie campaign leading all NBA rookies in **blocks (1.67), rebounds (8.3), field goal percentage (.508) and double-doubles (21)**. He also ranked 2nd among rookies in **MPG (33.8)**, 5th in **PPG (15.0)**, 7th in **SPG (0.81)** and 8th in **APG (2.5)**.

- Mobley became just the **4th rookie in NBA history to average at least 14.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.5 blocks**, joining Pau Gasol (2001-02), Tim Duncan (1997-98) and Chris Webber (1993-94).
- His **21 double-doubles were tied for the 4th-most ever by a Cavaliers rookie**.

Mobley had **at least one block in 56 games**, the **2nd-most in the entire NBA** behind only Memphis' Jaren Jackson Jr. (71 games).

- Mobley posted **36 multi-block performances** which were more than the rest of the top five NBA Draft picks in his class combined (25) and recorded a **block in 10 straight games or more on three occasions** (13 straight from Nov. 1-Dec. 5, 11 straight from March 4-24 and 10 straight from Jan. 4-22).

- His 13 straight contests with a block from Nov. 1 to Dec. 5 was the **longest streak by a Cavaliers rookie John "Hot Rod" Williams from Feb. 22-March 18, 1987** (also 13 games).
- Mobley finished the season with **115 blocks**, the **4th-highest total all-time by a rookie in franchise history**.

- Mobley won the **NBA Eastern Conference Rookie of the Month Award for October and November** when he totaled 244 points, 136 rebounds, 42 assists, 16 steals and 30 blocks, becoming just the 4th rookie in NBA history to accumulate those totals in their first 17 career games (Bill Walton, Mychal Thompson and Chris Webber).
