CAVS QUICK FACTS

🏆 Cleveland is playing Chicago for their first of four matchups this season (Dec. 17 at CHI, Dec 19 vs. CHI, March 19 at CHI). The Cavs are 17-4 against teams in their own Central Division since 2024 and have won 11 of their last 12 games against the Bulls since 2022. Cleveland won its previous game last night 148-114 (+34) over Washington. The Cavs 148 points were tied for 3rd-most points scored in a game in team history. 148 PTS is also the most PTS scored by a team in the NBA this season. Cleveland has scored 280 points combined in their last two games, the 2nd-most points scored in a two-game span in team history. Cleveland also grabbed 25 offensive rebounds in the win, their most OREB in a game since 2/5/14 vs. LAL.

🏆 **DONOVAN MITCHELL** finished with a game-high 24 PTS, including 4-10 (.400) shooting from the 3-point line, 5 AST, 5 REB, a game-high 4 STL and 1 BLK in 26 MIN last night vs. WAS. He has recorded at least 5 AST in 6 of his 8 games played this season. Mitchell is shooting 34-76 (.447) from the 3-point line this season and his **34 made 3-pointers is tied for the 2nd-most triples made in the NBA this season**. He also ranks **5th in the NBA** so far this season in points per game (30.9 PPG). **Mitchell has the highest scoring average (29.3 PPG in 19 games vs. CHI) against the Bulls of ANY player in NBA history, and scored his career-high 71 PTS vs. CHI on Jan. 2, 2023.**

🏆 **DARIUS GARLAND** finished with 20 PTS, including 4-9 (.444) shooting from the 3-point line, 9 AST and 1 STL in 28 MIN last night vs. WAS. With his first triple of the game, **Garland made his 900th career three-pointer, becoming the 3rd player in Cavaliers team history to make 900+ 3-pointers for the franchise (LeBron James - 1,251 3FGM, Kevin Love - 1,096 3FGM).**

🏆 **JARRETT ALLEN** contributed his second DBL-DBL of the season with 16 PTS, a season-high 14 REB (8 OREB), 2 STL and 1 BLK in 26 MIN on Nov. 7 vs. WAS. It was the 10th game in his career grabbing at least 8 offensive rebounds.

🏆 **EVAN MOBLEY** tallied his 3rd DBL-DBL of the season with 18 PTS, 10 REB, 3 AST, 1 STL and 1 BLK in 28 MIN last night vs. WAS. He is 17 blocks shy of passing Jim Chones (450 BLK) for the 6th-most blocks in Cavaliers history. **Mobley is the only player in the NBA this season with at least 15 BLK and 15 STL**, ranking 6th in the NBA in BPG (1.67) and 10th in the NBA in SPG (1.78). He has recorded a blocked shot in all 9 games for the Cavaliers this season.

🏆 **SAM MERRILL** tallied 14 PTS, including 4-5 (.800) shooting from the 3-point line, 2 AST and 1 STL in 18 MIN off the bench last night vs. WAS. **Merrill is shooting 26-45 (.578) from the 3-point line this season and a perfect 11-11 from the free throw line**. He is averaging 16.2 PPG in 24.6 MPG during his 6 games played this season. **His .578 3FG% this season ranks 4th in the NBA**. He now also ranks 5th in Cavs history for 3-pointers made off the bench (274) behind Daniel Gibson (411 3FGM), Damon Jones (329 3FGM), Danny Ferry (307 3FGM), Cedi Osman (296 3FGM). **Merrill is the 2nd player in NBA history to make at least 26 three-pointers on .570+ 3FG% in the first six games to start a season (OJ Mayo, DAL - 26-43, .605 in 2012).**

🏆 **TYRESE PROCTOR** finished with a career-high 17 PTS, including 5-6 (.833) shooting from the 3-point line and 3 AST in 19 MIN off the bench on Nov. 7 at WAS. **He is the first rookie in Cavs history to make at least 5 3-pointers in a game in fewer than 20 minutes played**. He is also the 18th rookie in NBA history to make at least 5 3-pointers in any single quarter.

🏆 **JAYLON TYSON** tallied 10 PTS, 4 REB and 1 STL in 23 MIN off the bench last night vs. WAS. **He has scored 10+ PTS in 5-straight games (15.0 PPG over that stretch), doing so for the 1st time in his career**. He is also shooting 19-42 (.452) from the 3-point line.

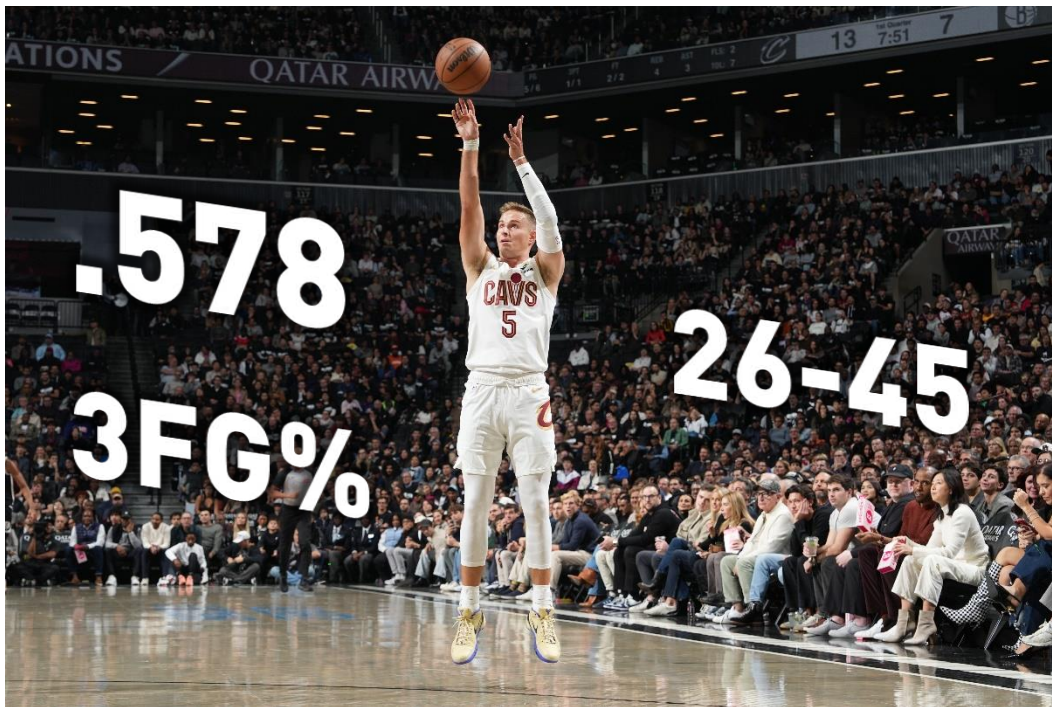

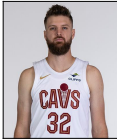
