## Dallas Connections

• Kayla Thornton (2017-2022) and Aerial Powers (2016-18) both overlapped with the Dallas Wings during the 2017 and 2018 seasons. Monique Billings (2024) and Veronica Burton (2022-23) also suited up for the Wings during their WNBA careers.

• Carla Leite was drafted ninth overall by Dallas during the 2024 draft. Leite did not play for Dallas as she remained overseas.

• Laeticia Amihere and Dallas guard Lyasha Harris played for South Carolina during the 2019-20 season.

• Kaitlyn Chen and Dallas guard Paige Bueckers both played for UConn, winning the 2025 NCAA Championship.

• Chloe Bibby and Teaira McCowan played together at Mississippi State from 2017-2019, leading the Bulldogs to the National Championship game in 2018 and the Elite Eight in 2019.

• Dallas assistant Camille Smith and Valkyries forward Stephanie Talbot both played for Phoenix in 2017 and 2018.

## Notes

• Kayla Thornton was named the WNBA Western Conference Player of the Week on Tuesday for week 4. Thornton averaged 20.0 points, 11.5 rebounds and 1.0 assist while shooting 43.8 percent (14-32) from the field, posting two double-doubles while leading Golden State to a 2-0 week. It's Thornton's first-ever Player of the Week award.

• Four of Golden State's five losses on the season have come to teams with a current combined record of 27-6. (New York: 9-1, Minnesota: 10-1; Phoenix: 8-4) (records as of 6/16)

• The Valkyries signed forwards Laeticia Amihere and Chloe Bibby, as well as guards Kaitlyn Chen and Aerial Powers to their active roster. Amihere was on Golden State's training camp roster, appearing in two preseason tune-ups for the Valkyries, and Powers brings nine WNBA seasons to the Bay. Powers played with Kayla Thornton in Dallas in 2017, and Laeticia Amihere in Atlanta in 2024. Bibby and Chen were also on Golden State's training camp roster.

• Tiffany Hayes is currently 35th on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,644), and 10th among active players. Hayes also ranks 11th among active players in career steals (365), and is one of 32 players all-time with over 4,500 points and 350 steals.

• Five Valkyries (Kayla Thornton - 3, Temi Fágbenlé - 2, Monique Billings, Veronica Burton, Janelle Salaün - 1) have recorded dou-

bles-doubles this season, which are the most players by any team in the WNBA. Thornton's four double-doubles are tied for the fifth most in the league.

• Veronica Burton's +40 against Las Vegas (June 7) was the 19th time a WNBA player has posted +40 or better in a game. Burton also posted her first career double-double that game with a career-best 12 assists and 14 points.

• Four current Valkyries have won the Commissioner's Cup in Cecilia Zandalasini (2024 with Minnesota), Kayla Thornton (2023 with New York), Head Coach Natalie Nakase (2022 with Las Vegas), and Stephane Talbot (2021 with Seattle).

• The Valkyries are the first WNBA team this season to have five players in double figures for three straight games (6/5 @ PHX, 6/7 vs. LVA, 6/9 @ LAS).

• Kayla Thornton is fourth in the league with 2.1 steals per game, and Temi Fágbenlé is 14th in the WNBA with a 53.7 field goal percentage (min. 10 FGA).

• Veronica Burton (91.1) is third all-time in WNBA history in free throw percentage among players with at least 100 career attempts (1. Elena Delle Donne: 93.7 (1115/1190); 2. Karlie Samuelson: 928 (103/111); Burton's 90.9 FT% this season is the seventh best in the league (min. 20 FTA).

• Golden State ranks second in the W with 37.0 rebounds per game, and first in defensive rebound percentage (The percentage of available defensive rebounds a player or team obtains while on the floor) at 74.9. The Valkyries are also second in steals per game with 8.8, second with a 82.7 free throw percentage, and are 54-60 (90.0 percent) the last three games from the line.

• Kayla Thornton has scored in double figures in nine consecutive games, including three straight double-doubles. Golden State is 5-0 when Thornton scores 14 or more points, and 4-0 when she records a double-double, this season.

• Saturday's game marked the third consecutive game, and fourth time overall, that Golden State has scored 40+ in the first half. The Valkyries are 4-0 when scoring 40-or-more in the first half in 2025.

• Against the Aces (6/7), Golden State had three players post double-doubles, which was the first time in the WNBA this season a team has had three players post double-doubles in the same game, and third time over the last two seasons (Indiana on 7/12/2024 and New York on 8/20/2024).

• The Valkyres are the fourth-fastest WNBA expansion team to reach five wins (excluding the 1997 season):

• Kayla Thornton recorded the first-ever points in franchise history at the 9:36 mark. Kate Martin handed out the first assist at 8:14, and Temi Fágbenlé knocked down the first three-pointer at 6:53 in the first quarter.

• Laeticia Amihere is 23 points away from 100 in her career (at 77).

• Monique Billings is 25 points from 1,400 (at 1,375).

• Veronica Burton is five steals from 100 (at 95) in her career.

• Aerial Powers is at 1,994 career points, six away from 2,000 in her career. She is also 9 games played away from 200 in her career.

• Stephanie Talbot is at 928 career points, 72 from 1,000.

• Kayla Thornton is five steals from 250 career steals.

- Kayla Thornton (2017-2022) and Aerial Powers (2016-18) both overlapped with the Dallas Wings during the 2017 and 2018 seasons. Monique Billings (2024) and Veronica Burton (2022-23) also suited up for the Wings during their WNBA careers.
- Carla Leite was drafted ninth overall by Dallas during the 2024 draft. Leite did not play for Dallas as she remained overseas.
- Laeticia Amihere and Dallas guard Lyasha Harris played for South Carolina during the 2019-20 season.
- Kaitlyn Chen and Dallas guard Paige Bueckers both played for UConn, winning the 2025 NCAA Championship.
- Chloe Bibby and Teaira McCowan played together at Mississippi State from 2017-2019, leading the Bulldogs to the National Championship game in 2018 and the Elite Eight in 2019.
- Dallas assistant Camille Smith and Valkyries forward Stephanie Talbot both played for Phoenix in 2017 and 2018.

Notes

- Four of Golden State's five losses on the season have come to teams with a current combined record of 27-6. (New York: 9-1, Minnesota: 10-1; Phoenix: 8-4) (records as of 6/16)
- The Valkyries signed forwards Laeticia Amihere and Chloe Bibby, as well as guards Kaitlyn Chen and Aerial Powers to their active roster. Amihere was on Golden State's training camp roster, appearing in two preseason tune-ups for the Valkyries, and Powers brings nine WNBA seasons to the Bay. Powers played with Kayla Thornton in Dallas in 2017, and Laeticia Amihere in Atlanta in 2024. Bibby and Chen were also on Golden State's training camp roster.
- Tiffany Hayes is currently 35th on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,644), and 10th among active players. Hayes also ranks 11th among active players in career steals (365), and is one of 32 players all-time with over 4,500 points and 350 steals.
- Five Valkyries (Kayla Thornton - 3, Temi Fágbenlé - 2, Monique Billings, Veronica Burton, Janelle Salaün - 1) have recorded double-doubles this season, which are the most players by any team in the WNBA. Thornton's four double-doubles are tied for the fifth most in the league.

- Veronica Burton's +40 against Las Vegas (June 7) was the 19th time a WNBA player has posted +40 or better in a game. Burton also posted her first career double-double that game with a career-best 12 assists and 14 points.
- Four current Valkyries have won the Commissioner's Cup in Cecilia Zandalasini (2024 with Minnesota), Kayla Thornton (2023 with New York), Head Coach Natalie Nakase (2022 with Las Vegas), and Stephane Talbot (2021 with Seattle).
- The Valkyries are the first WNBA team this season to have five players in double figures for three straight games (6/5 @ PHX, 6/7 vs. LVA, 6/9 @ LAS).
- Kayla Thornton is fourth in the league with 2.1 steals per game, and Temi Fágbenlé is 14th in the WNBA with a 53.7 field goal percentage (min. 10 FGA).
- Veronica Burton (911) is third all-time in WNBA history in free throw percentage among players with at least 100 career attempts (1. Elena Delle Donne: 93.7 (1115/1190); 2. Karlie Samuelson: 928 (1033/111); Burton's 90.9 FT% this season is the seventh best in the league (min. 20 FTA).
- Golden State ranks second in the W with 37.0 rebounds per game, and first in defensive rebound percentage (The percentage of available defensive rebounds a player or team obtains while on the floor) at 74.9. The Valkyries are also second in steals per game with 8.8, second with a 82.7 free throw percentage, and are 54-60 (90.0 percent) the last three games from the line.
- Kayla Thornton has scored in double figures in nine consecutive games, including three straight double-doubles. Golden State is 5-0 when Thornton scores 14 or more points, and 4-0 when she records a double-double, this season.
- Saturday's game marked the third consecutive game, and fourth time overall, that Golden State has scored 40+ in the first half. The Valkyries are 4-0 when scoring 40-or-more in the first half in 2025.
- Against the Aces (6/7), Golden State had three players post double-doubles, which was the first time in the WNBA this season a team has had three players post double-doubles in the same game, and third time over the last two seasons (Indiana on 7/12/2024 and New York on 8/20/2024).
