- Four of Golden State's five losses on the season have come to teams with a current combined record of 25-5 (New York: 9-0, Minnesota: 9-1; Phoenix: 7-4) (records as of 6/13)
- The Valkyries signed forward Laeticia Amihere and guard Aerial Powers to their active roster. Amihere was on Golden State's training camp roster, appearing in two preseason tune-ups for the Valkyries, and Powers brings nine WNBA seasons to the Bay. Powers played with Kayla Thornton in Dallas in 2017, and Laeticia Amihere in Atlanta in 2024.
- Tiffany Hayes is currently 35th on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,644), and 10th among active players. Hayes also ranks 11th among active players in career steals (365), and is one of 32 players all-time with over 4,500 points and 350 steals.
- Five Valkyries (Kayla Thornton 3, Temi Fágbénlé 2, Monique Billings, Veronica Burton, Janelle Salaün 1) have recorded doubles-doubles this season, which is the most players by any team in the WNBA.
- Veronica Burton's +40 against Las Vegas (June 7) was the 19th time a WNBA player has posted +40 or better in a game. Burton also posted her first career double-double that game with a career-best 12 assists and 14 points.
