Sparks Connections and Key Performances

- Stephanie Talbot was selected from the Sparks in the 2024 Expansion Draft.
- Kayla Thornton went 6-for-7 from deep against the Sparks on 6/22/24, marking the 31st time a player has knocked down six three-pointers in no more than seven attempts in WNBA history.
- Monique Billings has recorded two double-doubles over her last five games versus Los Angeles.

Roster Breakdown

- International: 6 players from 5 different countries (Australia, Belgium, France, Italy, United Kingdom)
- Rookies: 3 (Leite, Linskens, Salaün)

- Temi Fágbénlé is coming off a 2024 campaign with Indiana in which she averaged 18.9 minutes, 6.4 points, 4.7 boards, 0.9 assists, 0.5 steals, and 0.7 blocks per game, all career bests for the center who is entering her fifth season in the W.
- Veronica Burton ranked 25th in the league last season in +/- at +3.5 on the year. Tiffany Hayes was 28th (+2.8) and Kayla Thornton was 29th (+2.7).

- Tiffany Hayes is also coming off of a strong 2024 season in which she was tabbed the league's Sixth Player of the Year. The lefty shot a career-high 50.0 percent (minimum 150 FGA) from the field, and 40.2 percent from deep which ranked 10th in the W.
- Tiffany Hayes is currently 35th on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,623), and 10th among active players. Hayes also ranks 11th among active players in career steals (364).
- Cecilia Zandalasini's 41.5 career three-point field goal percentage is currently 10th all-time in WNBA history and third among active players (min. 25 3FGM).
- Veronica Burton has a career 91.3 free throw percentage, which is the third best in league history (min. 50 free throws made). Burton has made 15 of her last 17 from the charity stripe.
- Julie Vanloo made 73 threes and handed out 173 assists in her rookie campaign last year, becoming one of two rookies in league history to have at least 70 made three-pointers and 150 assists (also Caitlin Clark in 2024).
- Golden State drew 17, 428 fans in its preseason opener on May 6, which was the third largest preseason crowd in WNBA history.
- The Valkyries scored 57 second-half points in its preseason opener and 55 in its second preseason game, outscoring both opponents in the final 20 minutes.

10,000 and Counting

• On March 26, 2025, the Golden State Valkyries eclipsed the 10,000 season ticket mark for the team's inaugural 2025 season, presented by Kaiser Permanente. The Valkyries, who are the first WNBA expansion team since 2008, became the first WNBA team on record to hit this milestone.

- Monique Billings is 4 assists away from 200 in her career (currently at 196).
- Tip Hayes is 1 offensive rebound away from 300 in her career (currently at 299).

NATALIE NAKASE HEAD COACH, GOLDEN STATE VALKYRIES

Experience: 1st Season School: UCLA - '03

Nakase enters her first season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces. Nakase will report to Valkyries General Manager Ohemaa Nyanin, and began her tenure with the team on October 21. Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

Nakase spent the last three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as

head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.

Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.
