

   General Manager Ohemaa Nyanin and Kayla Thornton won a WNBA Championship with New York in 2024. Thornton played in New York for two seasons, averaging 4.9 points and 3.0 rebounds per game for the Liberty.
- Monique Billings and Liberty G/F Kennedy Burke played together at UCLA for three seasons from 2015-16 to 2017-18, guiding the Bruins to two Sweet Sixteens and one Elite Eight in the NCAA Tournament.

   Tiffany Hayes is currently 35th on the WNBA's all-time scoring list (4,644), and 10th among active players. Hayes also layers in career steals (365). ranks 11th among active players in career steals (365)
- Temi Fágbénlé is coming off a 2024 campaign with Indiana in which she averaged 18.9 minutes, 6.4 points, 4.7 boards, 0.9 assists, 0.5 steals, and 0.7 blocks per game, all career bests for the center who is entering her fifth season in the W.
- Veronica Burton ranked 25th in the league last season in +/- at +3.5 on the year. Tiffany Hayes was 28th (+2.8) and Kayla Thornton was 29th (+2.7).
- Tiffany Hayes is also coming off of a strong 2024 season in which she was tabbed the league's Sixth Player of the Year. The lefty shot a career-high 50.0 percent (minimum 150 FGA) from the field, and 40.2 percent from deep which ranked 10th in the W.
- Cecilia Zandalasini's 41.5 career three-point field goal per-

centage is currently 10th all-time in WNBA history and fourth among active players (min. 25 3FGM).

- Golden State drew 17, 428 fans in its preseason opener on May 6, which was the third largest preseason crowd in WNBA history.
- The Valkyries drew a sellout attendance of 18,064 during their home opener on May 16, which is the second-highest attendance by a WNBA team in their first-ever home game (Washington Mystics - 20,674 on 6/19/1998). That attendance was also the sixth highest in a team's first home game of the season. Golden State followed up with another sold-out crowd on May 21 wiht 18,064 fans.
- · Veronica Burton (0.919) is third all-time in WNBA history in free throw percentage among players with at least 100 career attempts (1. Elena Delle Donne: 0.937 (1115/1190); 2. Karlie Samuelson: 0.927 (102/110)).
- Golden State paces the league with 10.3 steals per game, and is second in free throw percentage at 84.0.
- Additionally, Golden State leads the W with 23.3 percent of its points coming from there free-throw line.
- The Valkyries are fifth in the league in defensive rating (how many points a team allows per 100 possessions on the defensive end) at 97.9.
- Janelle Salaün is fourth among rookies with 12.3 PPG. second with 6.0 RPG, and third with a 47.1 3FG%. Carla Leite is t-4th with 2.0 APG.
- Golden State leads the WNBA in percentage of points coming off turnovers at 25.0, and second in percentage of points coming from three-point range (37.0). The Valkyries have assisted on 53.4 percent of two-point field goals, which paces the W.
- Kayla Thornton recorded the first-ever points in franchise history at the 9:36 mark. Kate Martin handed out the first assist at 8:14, and Temi Fágbénlé knocked down the first three-pointer at 6:53 in the first quarter.
- Veronica Burton (3.0) and Kayla Thornton (2.8) are first and second, respectively, in the league in steals per game.
- Carla Leite is seventh in the W with 3.5 fast break points per contest.
- Temi Fágbénlé is shooting 62.5 percent in the paint, which is the second highest in the league. Fágbénlés 621 overall field goal percentage is also the second best in the W.
- Veronica Burton is 11 steals away from 100 in her career (currently at 89).
- Kayla Thornton is at 1,978 career points, 22 away from 2,000.

10,000 and Counting
• On March 26, 2025, the Golden State Valkyries eclipsed the 10,000 season ticket mark for the team's inaugural 2025 season, presented by Kaiser Permanente. The Valkyries, who are the first WNBA expansion team since 2008, became the first WNBA team on record to hit this milestone.

## NATALIE NAKASE HEAD COACH, GOLDEN STATE VALKYRIES

Experience: 1st Season School: UCLA - '03

Nakase enters her first season as head coach of the Golden State Valkyries. Nakase takes the helm of the Valkyries following over 16 years of coaching professional basketball, including 10 seasons in the NBA with the Los Angeles Clippers, and three seasons as first assistant coach with the Las Vegas Aces. Nakase will report to Valkyries General Manager Ohemaa Nyanin, and began her tenure with the team on October 21. Nakase is the first Asian American head coach in the WNBA, and was the first female coach to sit on an NBA team's bench when she was an assistant coach for the Los Angeles Clippers during the 2014 summer league.

Nakase spent the last three years (2022-2024) as first assistant coach with the Aces, where she played a critical role guiding the team to back-to-back WNBA Championships (2022, 2023). During her tenure, Las Vegas topped the WNBA's defensive rating charts in 2023, with a rating of 97.7. She assisted with in-game adjustments, substitution rotations, end of game decisions, time out strategies, head coach's challenge usages, clock management and organizing the team on both ends of the court. Nakase also served as the Aces top scout for college and international athletes. With Nakase on the sideline, the Aces went 87-29 over the last three seasons, including a 19-6 mark in the playoffs.

Prior to her time with the Aces, Nakase spent 10 seasons in various capacities with the Clippers, most recently as an assistant coach and player development coach in a dual role with the NBA team and their G League affiliate, the Agua Caliente Clippers. There, she assisted then-Head Coach Tyronn Lue with in-game planning on offense and defense, and assisted with player development and defensive scouting reports.

Nakase got her coaching start in 2008 with the Women's Professional Basketball German League, serving as

head coach for the Wolfenbuttel Wildcats for two seasons (2008-10). She then served as an assistant coach for the Tokyo Apache for one season (2010-11) in the Men's Professional Basketball Japan League, followed by acting as head coach for the Saitama Broncos from 2011-12, making her the first woman to serve as head coach in the league.

Nakase was a walk-on women's basketball player at University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) from 1998-2003, where she played her way into the starting lineup and served as team captain for three seasons. A native of Los Angeles, she graduated with her bachelor of science in psychology. After graduation, she played professionally for two years in the National Women's Basketball League (NWBL) with the San Jose Spiders and San Diego Siege. Nakase also competed for one season in Germany, where she suffered a career-ending knee injury in 2008.
